OVERVIEW

Built by the renowned Abeking & Rasmussen shipyard in Germany and with Philip Rhodes naval design, SEA PRINCE is a graceful and technically superior sailing yacht. She underwent a refit in 2005 followed by a substantial refresh of interiors in 2017. She is in excellent condition and many of her original fixtures and fittings remain.

SEA PRINCE offers accommodation for up to 8 guests and 4 crew to ensure that guests are looked after to a standard befitting this exclusive yacht. Her charming teak interiors combined with the refresh of materials fixtures and fittings has created a cozy and relaxing atmosphere.

Powered by a Detroit Diesel (8V71) 330 hp diesel engine SEA PRINCE has a top speed of 12 knots and comfortably cruises at 9 knots. She has a maximum range of 3,500 nautical miles at 9 knots. Her water tanks store around 7,000 litres of fresh water. Brand new water maker and new batteries have been fitted.

She was built to Lloyds Register classification society rules.
